

A. SARAWAK DELTA GEOPARK LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

To participate in the competition, eligible participants must:

- a) create Logo designs in .jpg or .png formats (if you are chosen as one of the winners, you **MUST** be able to provide a high-resolution vector file (.ai).
- b) complete the official Entry Form below and upload your design file and submit to the administrator email address inserted in the Entry Form. Submissions will only open on **Monday, 8 February 2021 and close on Sunday, 7 March 2021.**

By participating in the competition, the participant declares and warrants that the Logo design submitted by such participant is his/her original work, has not been submitted to any other competition, and does not infringe any third party's intellectual property rights.

Any complaints that may arise due to similarities, likeness or comparison of the Logo design would be the sole accountability and liability of the participant as he/she would be responsible to prove its authenticity.

Each participant further agrees to fully indemnify Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee against any and all claims, demands, proceedings, costs and expenses that may be suffered by Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee arising out of the participant's Logo infringing a third party's intellectual property right.

By participating in the competition, each participant represents and warrants that he/she has read and agrees to be bound by the competition's terms and conditions. Each participant further understands that if his/her logo designs are selected as the winner, he/she will relinquish all claims, rights (including any moral rights), and benefits related to the display, modification, reproduction, publication, distribution, use, and other exploitations of the work, other than the prize awarded to the winning entry. A submission form must accompany each logo design submissions.

Each participant authorizes Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee to utilize, in any manner and at any time as they deem fit, the entry or any part thereof, and to make derivative works from such material.

Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee shall also have exclusive rights to the submitted Logo designs; publish it on its websites, and in any other media and corporate materials. Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee reserve the right to further refine or make improvements and alterations on the final artwork, if necessary, of the winning entry; or not to use the winning entry as the final logo for the brand.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

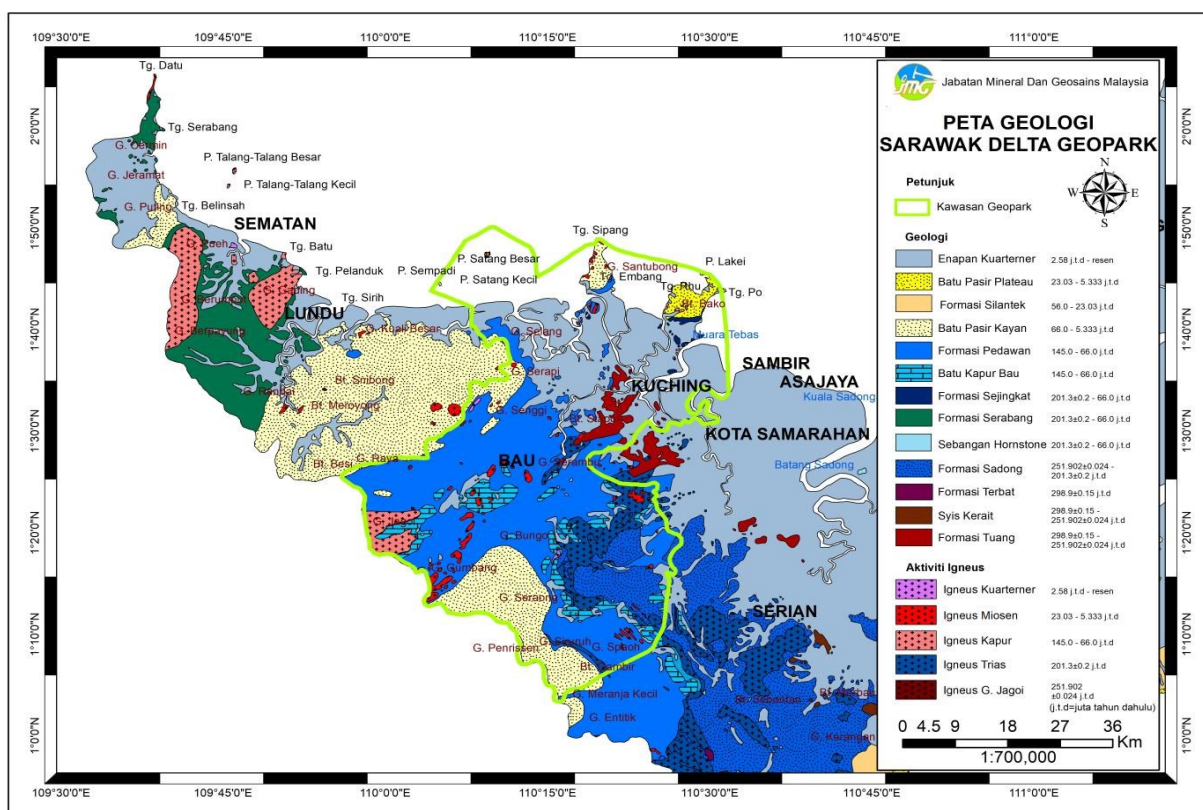
The purpose of the logo design competition is to design a logo for Sarawak Delta Geopark that serves as a single and unified geographical area where sites and landscapes of international or national geological significance are managed with a holistic concept of protection, education and sustainable development. The Logo may be used in all media platforms - including but not limited to online, print, merchandise materials and other visual collaterals. Following are the official Contest rules:

1. The competition is open to Malaysian citizens aged 18 years old and above.
2. The competition is open for submission on **Monday, 8 February 2021 and close on Sunday, 7 March 2021.**
3. The closing date is Sunday, 7 March 2021 at midnight. Only entries received up to and including the closing date/time will be eligible.
4. The **winner will be notified within fourteen (14) days** of the closing date of the competition.
5. Participants may submit a maximum of three (3) entries. A separate Entry Form must accompany each submission.
6. All submitted work must be the original work of the participant(s) and must not include, be based on, or derived from any pre-existing or third-party designs, trademarks, or copyrighted images that may infringe such third party's intellectual property rights.
7. All entries will become the sole property of Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee. By submitting an entry, participant agrees that any and all intellectual property rights in relation to the Logo designed and submitted by the participant shall be deemed assigned to Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee.
8. Except where prohibited by law, an entry submission into this competition constitutes permission to use the winner's name, likeness, prize information, and information provided on the entry form for publicity purposes, without further permission from, notice or compensation to the winner.
9. Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee reserves the right to modify the winning Logo to better fit the needs of the initiative.
10. Entries should be done and submitted in digital format (at least 300 dpi with a file extension of .jpg or .png).
 - a. The raw file of the digital artwork should be illustrated in A4 size using Adobe Illustrator (.ai). Submit the file in the following formats:
 - i. Flat JPEG or PNG format.
 - ii. Filename is your name and design number. Example: alibaba_design1.jpg, alibaba_design1.png.
 - b. The logo must contain the words "Sarawak Delta Geopark".
 - c. A brief description or rationale (not more than 300 words) explaining the components of the logo designs should also be included in each entry.
 - d. **Online Submissions: Complete entry form and digital artwork (JPEG or PNG) must be submitted to email address: mtac@sarawak.gov.my**
11. The Logo shall not carry ANY mention. For example, Watermarks, Trademarks, Signatures, Name, Initials and Markings.
12. The selected winners MUST submit a high-resolution vector file (.ai) and of the winning designs so that it is adaptable to electronic and print media, to reproduce on small and large surfaces, and to use in colour or in grey scale.

13. The decisions of the Selection Committee formed by Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee will be final. The winners shall be informed through email and/or telephone call.
14. In the event of any dispute arising from this competition, the participants irrevocably and unconditionally accept that the decisions of Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee are final and binding with regards to all matters in relation to and all aspects of this competition.
15. By participating in this competition, the participants irrevocably agree to be bound by the terms and conditions herein stated.
16. All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the entrant agrees to abide by these rules. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
17. Sarawak's State Geopark Steering Committee reserves its rights to add, delete, amend or modify the terms and conditions herein at its sole discretion and shall be at its liberty to terminate this competition at any time without notice and/or compensation to the participants.

B. DESCRIPTIONS FOR SARAWAK DELTA GEOPARK (SDG) LOGO COMPETITION

1. The logo should be simple and not complicated but reflect or in line with the proposed name Sarawak Delta Geopark.
2. It should highlight the unique geological features, natural landscape and cultural heritage of Sarawak Delta Geopark area.
3. The logo should consist of either all the three or at least combination of two of these elements; the main morphology, the main rock formations and the main local community culture within Sarawak Delta Geopark area.
4. Morphology also known as the landform, for examples; delta, river, mountain, lake, valley, ridges/range and etc.
5. The main rock formations are referring to the significance rocks types or rock features or soil features that became the foundation of development and civilization within Sarawak Delta Geopark or Kuching zone. It should be part of the evidence for the geological history (geological evolution) either for Sarawak or Borneo mainland or Asian region. The location and geological map of Sarawak Delta Geopark showing all rock formations with respective age in million years is attached.
6. The cultural elements should reflect the harmonious multi-ethnic diversity of Sarawak or the main cultural heritage in Sarawak Delta Geopark area.
7. The logo should also indicate the state government's intention towards developing an environmentally friendly, nature conservation and sustainable geological heritage.
8. The font type and size used for the word Sarawak Delta Geopark should be appropriate and clear.
